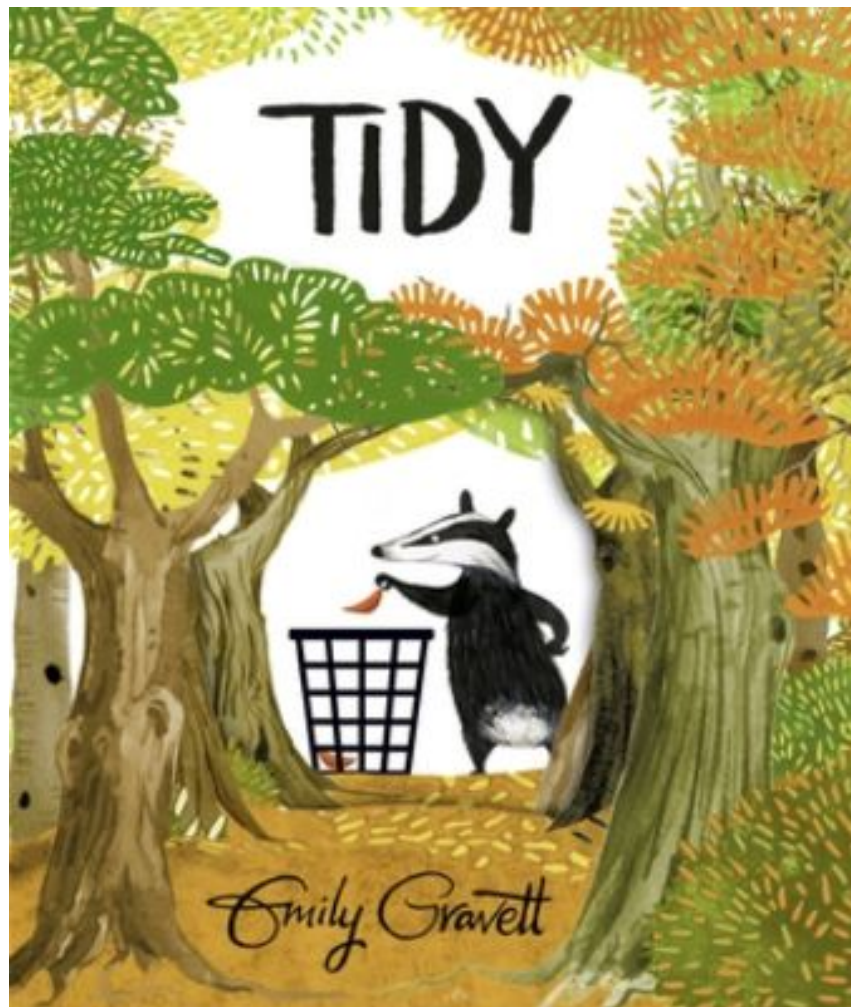

IF THE LETTER BEFORE THE Y IS A CONSONANT	We change the Y to an I And add ES
